The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

08/08/2022

Fraud on Inn Keeper/Attempt Burglary/Disorderly Conduct/Probation Violation S 122 St/W Bel Mar Dr

On Monday, 08/08/22, at 0249 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Fraud on Innkeeper after taking a taxi from E Oklahoma Ave and S Kinnickinnic Ave in Milwaukee to Franklin and refused to pay the fare on arrival. He then tried to force entry to a residence at that location, causing a disturbance. He was booked and later turned over to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office.
