02/21/22

Restraining Order Violation 7900 Blk Chapel Hill Ct S

On Monday, 02/21/22, at 1719 hours, a Franklin resident reported she received flowers and a note she believed was sent by a known subject in violation of a restraining order between them. Follow-up to continue.

The vehicle then caused a crash at the intersection of 27th and Rawson Ave before fleeing via I 94. Follow up to continue.
