Battery - Domestic Violence **10741 S 27th St - On the Border**

On Friday, 02/25/22, at 2330 hours, at On the Border, a victim reported her husband physically assaulted her, causing injuries and requiring hospitalization. Contact was made with husband who refused to turn himself in. Follow up to continue.
