# Here is a list of notable events from the last week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **07/18/2022**

### **Warrant Arrest 8361 S 27 St-Skyway Motel**

On Monday, 07/18/22, at 1117 hours, at the Skyway Motel, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for having warrants with Green Lake Co Sheriff's Office for Ignition Interlock Device Tampering and Manitowoc PD for Failure to Appear In Court. He was later turned over to Manitowoc PD.

### **Possession of Drug Paraphernalia 7963 S 116 St-St Martins of Tours Church/Cemetery**

On Monday, 07/18/22, at 1338 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia after an employee of St Martin of Tours Catholic Church called stating there was a vehicle parked near the cemetery and a male subject got out and ran into the woods. He was booked, cited, and released.

On Monday, 07/18/22, at approximately 1102 hours, the Franklin Police Department assisted the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office with the investigation of the death of an 83 year old Franklin resident.

**Retail Theft, Resisting Arrest, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Disorderly Conduct  
6489 S 27th Street-Home Depot**

On Monday, 07/18/22, at 1830, a subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft, Resisting Arrest, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Disorderly Conduct. This occurred after he attempted to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$158.00. He then fled from officers on foot, ran through several businesses on South 27th Street, and was taken into custody near Starbucks. He was issued citations and released with charges for Retail Theft being referred to the District Attorney's Office for review based on previous offenses.

The occupants of the vehicle fled on foot in the City of Milwaukee and later identified by Greendale PD. Charges were referred to the DA's Office.

On Tuesday, 07/19/22, the Franklin Police Department assisted the West Allis Police Department with the arrest of a Homicide suspect wanted by their department. The subject was staying at the Embassy Motel.

**Retail Theft, Possession of Controlled Substance  
6701 S 27th St-Walmart**

On Wednesday, 07/20/22, at 1340 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Retail Theft and Possession of Marijuana. At the same time, another subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft and possession of psilocybin (hallucinogenic mushrooms) and another subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Retail Theft and for having a valid warrant with Florence County Sheriff's Department for Failure to Pay Fines - Original Charge Forgery, and a Department of Corrections warrant for Theft. The first two subjects were booked, cited, and released with charges for the mushrooms being referred to the District Attorney's Office. The latter was transported to County Jail.

On Wednesday, 07/20/22, an as-yet unidentified subject called in a bomb threat to the Salvation Army. The store was evacuated by staff, searched by two MPD bomb detection dogs, and nothing was located.

**Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1<sup>st</sup> Offense

On Saturday, 07/23/22, at 0310 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1<sup>st</sup> Offense pursuant to a traffic stop. He later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.09. He was booked, cited, and released to a responsible party. His vehicle was towed from the scene.
