Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

06/13/2022

Retail Theft 6701 S 27th St - Walmart

On Monday, 06/13/22, at 1254 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft after attempting to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$68.38. He was booked, cited, and released.

Recklessly Endangering Safety 7500 Blk S 75th Street

On Monday, 06/13/22, at 2039 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Recklessly Endangering Safety and 2 counts of Child Abuse. This occurred after she stabbed two juveniles inside the residence, causing non life-threatening injuries. She was turned over to County Jail. Charges were referred to the DA's Office.

06/14/2022

Destruction of Property 9000 Blk W Elm Ct

On Tuesday, 06/14/22, a Franklin resident reported that sometime between 0000 hours and 0100 hours, unknown actor(s) smashed the front driver side window on his vehicle and proceeded to spread pomade on the inside of the windshield. Follow up to continue.

Destruction of Property 6807 S 27 St – AT&T

On Tuesday, 06/14/22, AT&T reported that someone had damaged the lock on the rear door of the business overnight. No entry was gained. Similar damage was found at the business next door.

On Tuesday, 06/14/22, at 2056 hours, 7-11 employees reported a physical altercation taking place in the parking lot. One of the combatants was pepper sprayed by the other during the incident. Both subjects were cited for Disorderly Conduct.

Disorderly Conduct – Domestic Violence related 7100 Blk S Ballpark Dr

On Tuesday, 06/14/22, at 2317, a Franklin resident was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence. This occurred after he pushed his roommate and damaged several items in the apartment causing the roommate to fear for her safety. The subject was booked, cited, and released after posting bail.

On Wednesday, 06/15/22, at approximately 0900 hours, in the FRPD Lobby, a subject was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with the Cudahy Police Department for Retail Theft. He was released after signing a Personal Recognizance bond.

Possession of Controlled Substance/Carrying Concealed Weapon 6701 S 27th St - Walmart

On Wednesday, 06/15/22, at approximately 1529 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana. At the same time, another subject was taken into custody for Carrying a Concealed Weapon. This occurred after dispatch received a call from an anonymous customer who was concerned about a child inside a vehicle in the parking lot with the windows rolled up. Contact was made with the "child", who turned out to be a young adult. This individual was discovered to be in possession of 10 grams of marijuana and a handgun with a drum magazine. Her friend claimed ownership of the marijuana and they were both taken into custody. Both were booked, cited, and released. Charges for CCW were referred to the DA's Office for review.

Burglary & Vehicle Entries Continued
8151 S 27th St- Plaza Motel

On Friday, 06/17/22, at 1846 hours, at the Plaza Motel, a subject out of Janesville was taken into custody for Burglary, Resisting Arrest, Theft from Motor Vehicle (Felony), Theft from Motor Vehicle (Misdemeanor) x3, Theft of Movable Property, Criminal Damage to Property x3. He was also taken into custody for having a valid warrant with WI Department of Corrections for a Probation Violation. This stemmed from the numerous Thefts, Entry to Autos & a Burglary from the day prior. Upon receiving yet another call for Prowling and Criminal Damage to Property, the subject fled the area. The drone was deployed and a foot chase resulted in the capture of the suspect. He was later turned over to County Jail with charges for the above offenses being referred to the DA's Office for review.
