06/15/2026

Missing Person Found W Loomis Rd/W Rawson Ave

On Monday, 06/15/26, at 0452 hours, a subject who had been entered as a missing person/Silver Alert through Justice Police Department (Illinois) was located during a traffic stop. He was reunited with his family.

Disorderly Conduct - Domestic Violence 3600 Blk W Central Ave

On Monday, 06/15/26, at 1655 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct – Domestic Violence related. This occurred after she broke items around the house and caused the victim to fear for his safety. She was booked and released after posting bail. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's office for review.

On Wednesday, 6/17/26, at 1042 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having an extraditable warrant out of Watauga PD in Texas for Theft of Property against an elderly person. This occurred pursuant to a vehicle check at the motel. He was booked and transported to County Jail where he will wait for extradition to Texas.

On Sunday, 06/21/26, at 1703 hours, a resident of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1st Offense. This occurred pursuant to a Reckless Driving complaint and officers observing him unable to maintain his lane. He later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated that he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.23. He was booked, cited, and turned over to a sober party.

On Sunday, 06/21/26, a victim reported being approached by two subjects in the parking lot of Pick N Save who told him they needed to buy plane tickets to return to Dubai. They offered to sell him Apple products so they could purchase the tickets. He gave the subjects approximately \$3,500 for the Apple products and a small bag of jewelry that later turned out to be fake.
