Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

06/06/2022

Disorderly Conduct While Armed 9575 S 27th St – Staybridge Suites

On Monday, 06/06/22, at 0101 hours, a subject out of Louisiana was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct while Armed. This occurred after he engaged in an altercation with another guest and armed himself with a hand sanitizer station (affixed to a metal pole). He was transported to County Jail and turned over to their personnel but was soon released. Charges were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

On Monday, 06/06/22, at 0322 hours, the Racine County Sheriff's Office (RASO) requested Mutual Aid to the area of S 27th St/W Elm Rd regarding a pursuit of a stolen vehicle. The vehicle, reported stolen by Kenosha County, was recovered.
