# Here is a list of notable events from the last week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **03/13/2023**

### **Carry Concealed Weapon W Puetz Rd/S Hunting Park Dr**

On Monday, 03/13/23, at 0328 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Carrying Concealed Weapon after two handguns were recovered from his vehicle. This occurred pursuant to a traffic stop. He was booked, cited, and released.

### **Warrant Arrest S 51st St/W Puetz Rd**

On Monday, 03/13/23, at 0632 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having two warrants with our department. She was released on scene after signing a Personal Recognizance bond.

### **Parole Violation, Carry Concealed Weapon, Possession of Controlled Substance 2300 Block W Rawson Ave**

On Tuesday, 03/14/23, at 0114 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Carrying a Concealed Weapon pursuant to a traffic stop. He was booked, cited, and released. His passenger, also out of Milwaukee, was taken into custody for Possession of THC and for Violation of Parole. He was booked, cited, and turned over to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility.

On Wednesday, 03/15/23, a resident reported she received a call from someone claiming to be her bank's Fraud Division informing her there was suspicious activity on her account and requested the full card numbers to her personal and business debit cards. On Wednesday, 03/15/23, at 1204 hours, in the wooded area just west of the Cedar Ridge Condos, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct and Obstructing an Officer. This occurred after the subject was observed having entered an FFD fire truck which was parked in the lot of Pick N Save. The subject then fled on foot from responding officers, leading them on a foot pursuit through the wooded area to the south of the business. He was booked, cited, and released with charges referred to the District Attorney's Office.

### **Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1<sup>st</sup> Offense 7600 Blk W Rawson Ave**

On Wednesday, 03/15/23, at 2158 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 1<sup>st</sup> Offense. He later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated that he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.12. He was booked, cited, and turned over to a sober party.
