03/14/22

Operating While Intoxicated 9900 Blk W Loomis Rd

On Monday, 03/14/22, at 0757 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating While Intoxicated-1st Offense. This occurred after his vehicle was observed swerving from his lane of traffic by an off-duty Officer. He provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated his blood alcohol concentration was 0.20. The subject was booked, cited, and released to a sober party.

Disorderly Conduct/Bail Jumping 4400 Blk W Central Ave

On Monday, 03/14/22, at approximately 1633 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct and Bail Jumping after he caused a disturbance at the residence. The subject, who was highly intoxicated, then went to the neighbor's house where he continued to cause a disturbance. He was booked, cited, and released. The Bail Jumping charge will be sent to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

Concealed Weapon****5040 W Rawson Ave – Kwik Trip**

On Tuesday, 03/15/22, at approximately 0214 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for Material Witness, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, and for Possession W/Intent to Deliver Narcotic Drugs (Fentanyl). Approximately six grams of Fentanyl was recovered. Several firearms, scales, ammunition, a small amount of THC, and a black hooded ski-mask were recovered from the vehicle. The subject was turned over to personnel at County Jail. A passenger in the vehicle was cited for Possession of THC and released.
