# Here is a list of notable events from the last week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **03/20/2023**

### **Mutual Aid – RSCO 4300 Blk W South County Line Rd**

On Monday, 03/20/23, the Racine County Sheriff's Office requested mutual aid in locating a vehicle involved in a pursuit in their county. Assistance was given and the driver was taken into custody.

### **Mutual Aid – New Berlin PD 15500 Blk W Beloit Rd**

On Monday, 03/20/23, New Berlin PD requested our K9 for traffic stop in the lot of Speedway at Beloit Rd/Moorland Rd. The driver and passenger were taken into custody by NBPD for drug-related charges based on their findings in the vehicle after a positive K9 indication on the car.

On Sunday, 03/26/23, at 1551 hours, a victim reported that her child's father made several threats towards her that caused her to fear for her safety. During the incident, the subject threw knives at the victim and caused damage to the property before taking the victim's vehicle without consent and fleeing the scene. The vehicle was later recovered and a warrant has been entered for the suspects arrest.
