# Here is a list of notable events from the past week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block. Incidents involving juveniles or mental health crises have been omitted.

## 03/21/22

### **Mutual Aid-Greendale PD S. 76th St./S. Ballpark Dr.**

West Allis PD was in pursuit of a vehicle southbound on S 76th from Howard Ave. The vehicle was successfully spiked by Greenfield PD and entered Greendale. The driver was taken into custody, however, a passenger fled from the vehicle. FRPD assisted with a perimeter and drone support. Officers were initially unable to locate the outstanding passenger, but Greendale PD later located and took him into custody. The suspect was armed with a handgun.

### **Recovered Stolen Property 6701 S 27th Street - Walmart**

On Monday, 03/21/22, at 1730 hours, Officers located a vehicle listed as stolen through Greenfield PD in the parking lot of Walmart. Two subjects were located inside the vehicle and were taken into custody. One of the passengers held a warrant with Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for Failure to Pay Child Support and was turned over to GFPD. GFPD responded to process the vehicle for evidence.

The victim was told over the phone someone hacked into his Amazon account and that he needed to purchase four (4) Target gift cards from various stores (\$500 each) and provide the gift card numbers to the caller.

*Crime prevention tip – There is no legitimate reason to EVER provide someone gift cards over the phone or internet. If you are ever asked for this, it is a scam. Gift cards are for gifts.*

**Strangulation-Domestic Violence****8151 S 27th St – Plaza Motel**

On Sunday, 03/27/22, at 1748 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Strangulation/Suffocation-Domestic, Disorderly Conduct, and Obstructing. This occurred at 1724 hours after he physically attacked and choked his live-in girlfriend until she reportedly lost consciousness. He also refused to identify himself and threatened to assault officers. He was later turned over to County Jail.
