Retail Theft, Warrant Arrest

On Thursday, 03/30/23, at 0937 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft, a warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for Retail Theft, and a warrant with South Milwaukee PD for Operating After Revocation. This occurred after he left Dunham's with unpaid merchandise valued at \$203.87. He was booked, cited, and released after signing Personal Recognizance bonds.

Reckless Driving, Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1st Offense W Loomis Rd/W St Martins Rd

This occurred after dispatch took a report of a reckless driver swerving all over the road. She provided an evidentiary blood sample, the results of which are not yet known.

Fleeing/Eluding, Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated S 76th St/W Rawson Ave

On Saturday, 04/01/23, at 0223 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Fleeing/Eluding and Reckless Driving. This occurred after he led officers on a 2.7 mile pursuit. At the time of his arrest, it was determined he was intoxicated. He later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.11. He was booked, cited, and turned over to County Jail with charges referred to the District Attorney's office.
