Possession of Controlled Substance - THC S 27th St/W College Ave

On Monday, 03/28/22, at 1053 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Possession of THC pursuant to a traffic stop. Subject was booked, cited, and released.

This occurred after he contacted the Petitioner via phone at her place of employment in Franklin and threatened her. Once in custody of FRPD, it was discovered the subject was in possession of Methamphetamine. The subject was turned over to County Jail personnel with charges being referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

Endangering Safety by Use of Dangerous Weapon
7800 Blk S Scepter Dr

On Tuesday, 03/29/22, at 2231 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Endangering Safety by Use of a Dangerous Weapon. This occurred after he unintentionally discharged a firearm by negligent handling of the weapon as he was cleaning it. The subject was booked and released on bail with charges referred to the DA's office for review.

**Fleeing-Eluding/Resisting Arrest/Recklessly Endangering Safety/Forgery
W Loomis Rd / W Rawson Ave**
