The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **05/01/2023**

### **Mutual Aid – Greenfield 4400 Blk S 27th St**

On Monday, 05/01/23, at 0147 hours, Greenfield PD requested the assistance of our drone unit in locating an armed subject who fled from a traffic stop.
