The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

05/15/2023

Burglary 4900 Blk W Berkshire Dr

On Monday, 05/15/23, a resident reported that at some time between 04/30/23 and 05/15/23, someone removed a large amount of jewelry from their home. This was done without consent.

Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1st Offense, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia S 76th St/W Ryan Rd

He was booked and transported to County Jail with charges referred to the District Attorney's office.
