05/16/2022

Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence 4100 Blk W Sharon Ln

On Monday, 05/16/22, at approximately 0605 hours, a subject out of West Allis was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence after she caused a disturbance at the residence in violation of an injunction protection order. She was booked and released after posting bail. Charges were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

Warrant Arrest 9600 Blk W Rawson Ave

On Monday, 05/16/22, at approximately 0842 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with Eau Claire County for Operating Without a License. This was pursuant to a welfare check called in on the subject. This occurred after FRPD took multiple calls about a subject at Walmart displaying a gun to customers. No one on scene wished to be a complainant, however, the subject admitted to officers that he was operating a motor vehicle which violated his open case bail restrictions. He was transported to County Jail with charges for Bail Jumping being referred to the DA's Office.

Juvenile Abuse/ Neglect

On Monday, 05/16/22, at 1710 hours, at Sam's Club, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Child Neglect. This occurred after she left her 7 year old child in her vehicle, unattended with the windows up with temperatures at 78° F for approximately 20 minutes before officers were able to gain entry. She was booked and released after posting bail. The child was turned over to his father. Child Protective Services was notified and charges were referred to the DA’s Office.

**Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence/Possession of Narcotics/Possession of THC/Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/Resisting Arrest

On Tuesday, 05/17/22, at 1105 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence. This occurred after he shoved his 32 weeks pregnant live-in girlfriend and threw her personal belongings outside of their apartment. The subject fled the apartment prior to Officer arrival and fled from Officers on foot when located nearby. When he was apprehended, he was in possession of narcotic drugs, THC, and drug paraphernalia. He was turned over to County Jail with charges being referred to the DA's Office.

Follow up to continue.

Recklessly Endangering Safety/Operating While Intoxicated – 2nd Offense (Passenger Under 16), Operate After Revocation W Loomis Rd/W Drexel Ave

On Thursday, 05/19/22, at approximately 2039 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 2nd Offense with Passenger Less Than 16 yrs and Recklessly Endangering Safety. This occurred after he was observed by Officers traveling at a high rate of speed into oncoming traffic and appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. He later provided an evidentiary blood sample at a nearby hospital after a warrant was completed, the results of which are not known at this time. The subject was booked, cited, and taken to County Jail

Eluding-Stolen Vehicle 6701 S 27th Street -Walmart

On Thursday, 05/19/22, at 2303 hours, Officers located a vehicle reported as stolen by Milwaukee Police Department on W Sycamore St at S 27th Street. Officers searched the area and found the vehicle, unoccupied, in the middle of the road, at approximately 6th and Becher Street. Subject(s) fled on foot in an unknown direction.
