### **Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated – 1<sup>st</sup> Offense, Hit and Run Crash, Possession of Controlled Substance 2800 Blk W Southland Dr**

On Monday, 05/18/26, at 0111 hours, a resident of Butler was taken into custody for Hit and Run and Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated- 1st Offense. This occurred after he struck a stationary Franklin PD squad and attempted to flee the scene. An evidentiary blood sample was obtained, the results of which are not yet known. He was booked, cited, and released to a sober party. A passenger was taken into custody for Possession of THC and was also booked, cited, and released.
