05/23/2022

Fraud 8500 Blk S River Terrace Dr

On Monday, 05/23/22, a Franklin Resident reported an unknown actor(s) opened a Midnight Velvet account using his personally identifying information. The actors used the account to obtain merchandise.

Retail Theft/Missing Person-found 6701 S 27th Street - Walmart

On Monday, 05/23/22, at 1700 hours, a subject out of Greenfield was taken into custody for Retail Theft after attempting to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$49.97. He was booked, cited, and released from the station. On Tuesday, 05/24/22, at 1151 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 4th Offense. This occurred after he was involved in an altercation with a female at the Plaza Motel. A search warrant was obtained for an evidentiary blood sample, the results of which are not yet known. The subject was later turned over to the Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility on a felony probation hold.

On Tuesday, 05/24/22, at approximately 1229 hours, the Franklin Police Department assisted the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office with the investigation of the death of a 78 year old Franklin resident.

Warrant Arrest
8973 S 27th St – El Rancho Motel

On Tuesday, 05/24/22, at approximately 1245 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with South Milwaukee Police Department for Possession of Intoxicants on the Street. This occurred after FRPD was called to the motel after the subject and his girlfriend had caused a disturbance there. Both subjects were cited on scene for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

The Wisconsin State Patrol engaged in a pursuit with the vehicle on I94 and successfully spiked it prior to the state line, however, the vehicle continued into Illinois where it evaded capture. The vehicle was later located abandoned in Lake Park, IL. Follow up to continue.
