The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## **05/08/2023**

### **Mutual Aid – Greenfield PD S 31st St/W Allerton Ave**

On Monday, 05/08/23, Greenfield PD requested mutual aid for a K9 walkaround on a vehicle they had stopped.

**Operating While Intoxicated Causing Injury  
S Lovers Lane Rd/W Rawson Ave**

On Monday, 05/08/23, at 1408 hours, a subject out of Burlington was taken into custody for Operating A Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated Causing Injury with passengers under 16 (Felony). This had occurred after she crossed the dividing median on S Lover's Lane Rd and struck another vehicle head on. Investigation revealed she was intoxicated at the time of the crash. A preliminary breath test showed she had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration Of 0.23. She later provided an evidentiary blood sample, the results of which are not yet known. She was booked and transported to County Jail with charges referred to the District Attorney's office for review.
