05/09/2022

Disorderly Conduct-Domestic Violence 9000 Blk W Meadow Ln

On Monday, 05/09/22, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct – Domestic Violence after a dispute with his wife at their residence which caused her to fear for her safety. The subject was booked, cited, and released after posting bail. Charges were sent to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

Threat Complaint 4600 Blk W Hilltop Ln

On Monday, 05/09/22, at 1057 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Threats to Law Enforcement after he sent an email threatening to kill police officers and a District Attorney with pipe bombs and Molotov cocktails. He had also made threats to kill his parents. The subject was turned over to County Jail and charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office.

On Monday, 05/09/22, a resident of Franklin reported that unknown actors opened a Credit Card in her name. She was alerted and cancelled the card before any transactions were made.

On Monday, 05/09/22, at 1309 hours, on the 7100 block South 27th Street, a subject out of Illinois was taken into custody for Retail Theft. This occurred on 05/06/22 when he took medication from the CVS pharmacy located at 5220 West Rawson Avenue. The total value of the items taken was \$354.40. He was booked, cited, and released after posting bail.

On Wednesday, 05/11/22, at 1032 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Trespassing and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. This occurred at Walmart after the subject was observed inside the store after having been trespassed from the property on a previous occasion. Drug paraphernalia was found on his person at the time of his arrest. The subject also had a valid warrant with MCSO for Retail Theft, however, they would not take custody of him due to the ongoing public health emergency.

The pursuit was terminated shortly before the vehicle crashed in Racine County. FRPD responded again at the request of OCPD and the driver was taken into custody. The driver suffered a medical emergency and was transported to an area hospital.

On Thursday, 05/12/22, at 1106 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of THC with Intent to Deliver and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia pursuant to a traffic stop. He was later booked and turned over to the Milwaukee County Jail.
