11/01/21

Controlled Substance 7500 BLK S 76th St

On Monday, 11/01/21, at 1103 hours, on the 7500 Block of South 76th Street, a resident of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana. The subject was booked at the Franklin Police Department and released with a citation.

11/02/21

Felon in Possession of a Firearm / Possess Controlled Substance 1400 BLK W College Ave

On Tuesday, 11/02/21, at approximately 0317 hours, in the 1400 block of West College Avenue, a resident of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Felon in Possession of Firearm and Possession of THC. This was pursuant to a traffic stop for an equipment violation. The suspect was transported to the Milwaukee Criminal Justice Facility.

On Wednesday 11/3/21 at 1147 hours, FRPD investigated a death at a residence in the city. The Milwaukee County Medical Examiners Office did not respond and the body was turned over to a funeral home.

Retail Theft

Domestic Violence - Battery

Subject was not on scene at the time of Officer arrival and charges for Domestic Violence – Battery were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

**Recklessly Endangering Safety / Weapons Violation
7720 W Rawson Ave - Root River Center**

On Friday, 11/5/2021, at approximately 2228 hours, Franklin dispatch received multiple calls of shots fired at the Root River Center. Officers responded and determined several shots had been fired at that location. A subject was transported to the hospital for lacerations sustained from her vehicle's windshield as it was struck by several bullets. No other subjects were injured. This investigation is still ongoing.

**Substantial Battery
9063 S 27th Street - Whispering Pines**

Officer were called to the business to investigate possible drug activity when they discovered a female victim who was injured and in distress. She advised her boyfriend had struck her in the face, causing injury. He had fled prior to Officer arrival. Victim was transported to the hospital for injuries sustained and a search was conducted for her assailant with negative results. Further investigation to follow.

**Obstructing / Felony Warrant
7780 S Lovers Lane Road - Pick N Save**

**Death Investigation
8973 S 27th St – El Rancho Motel**

On Saturday, 11/06/21, Franklin Officers Responded to the El Rancho Motel for a death investigation involving a suspected drug overdose. The subject was pronounced deceased on scene by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office who will be conducting their investigation. Another subject on scene was taken into custody for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. This subject was later booked, cited, and released from the Police Station.

Warrant Arrest / Trespassing
