11/22/21

Operating While Intoxicated – 1st Offense W Drexel Ave/S 51st St

On Monday, 11/22/21, at approximately 0258 hours, at West Drexel Avenue and South 51st Street, a subject out of South Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 1st. The subject later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated that he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.18. The subject was booked, cited, and released to a sober party.
