On Friday, 12/03/21, at 0234 hours, on 110 East Layton Avenue, City of Milwaukee, a subject was taken into custody for Fleeing/Eluding and 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety. This occurred after the subject was observed traveling in excess of 100 miles per hour on South 27th Street at Northwestern Mutual Way and led officers on an 8.7 mile pursuit.
