11/08/21

OMVWI-1ST Offense 10700 BLK S 27th St.

On Monday, 11/08/21, at 0115 hours, in the 10700 block of S 27 St, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated - 1st Offense. This occurred after he crashed his motorcycle in the median in front of On the Border Gentleman's Club. The subject later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated he had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.22. His motorcycle was towed from the scene.

Controlled Substance W Loomis Rd / W Ramsey Ave

On Thursday, 11/11/21, at 1642 hours, a 40 year old Franklin resident was pronounced deceased by the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner. Investigation into the cause of death to follow.

On Thursday, 11/11/21, at 2303 hours, on the 8900 block of South 27th Street, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff for Possession of Narcotics as well as new charges for Possession of Heroin and Drug Paraphernalia.

Possession of THC & Drug Paraphernalia
3200 BLK W Rawson Ave

On Thursday, 11/11/21, at 2106 hours, on the 3200 BLK of West Rawson Avenue, a subject out of Chicago was taken into custody for Possession of THC and Drug Paraphernalia pursuant to a traffic stop for a seatbelt violation. Subject was booked, cited, and released.
