# Here is a list of notable events from the last week!

Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

## 11/14/2022

### **Recovered Stolen Vehicle/Plates 6537 S 27 St - Starbucks**

On Monday, 11/14/22, at 0213 hours, in the parking lot of Starbucks, a vehicle reported as stolen through South Milwaukee PD was located unoccupied. It had two different stolen plates attached to it. The vehicle was turned over to SMPD and the stolen license plates were destroyed per Milwaukee PD.

## 11/15/2022

*On Tuesday, 11/15/22, FRPD responded to 23 disabled vehicles and vehicle crashes due to the poor road conditions.*

### **Restraining Order Violation 7500 Blk S 31st Street**

On Tuesday, 11/15/22, a Franklin resident reported that a subject had called and left a message on her voicemail the previous day. This was done in violation of a court order prohibiting the subject from contacting the victim. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's office for review.

**Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated -1<sup>st</sup> Offense  
W St Martins Rd/W Puetz Rd**

On Tuesday, 11/15/22, at approximately 1721 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated. This occurred at W Saint Martins Rd and W Puetz Rd after the subject was involved in a crash and his vehicle was found in a ditch. He later provided an evidentiary blood sample, the results of which are not yet known. He was booked, cited, and turned over to a sober party. His vehicle was towed from the scene.

**11/16/2022**

**Warrant Arrest  
9419 S 27th St -Travelers Motel**

On Wednesday, 11/16/22, a subject was taken into custody on a warrant with the Oak Creek Police Department for a traffic violation. The subject was released after signing a Personal Recognizance bond.

**Fraud  
9000 Blk S 84th St**

On Wednesday, 11/16/22, a subject came in to the Police Department to report an unknown subject used his personally identifying information to take out a home equity line of credit on his residence. They then withdrew approximately \$30,000 from this account. This was done without the victim's consent.

**Restraining Order Violation  
8200 Blk S Shadwell Cir**

On Wednesday, 11/16/22, a resident of Franklin reported receiving text messages from a subject she had taken a Restraining Order out against. The case was referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.

**Possession of Controlled Substance, Open Intoxicant in Vehicle  
4600 Blk W Rawson Ave**

On Wednesday, 11/16/22, at approximately 2204 hours, a subject out of Austin, TX, was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana pursuant to a traffic stop. He was booked, cited, and released.

## **11/17/2022**

*On Thursday, 11/17/22, Officers responded to 17 crashes and 10 disabled vehicles due to poor road conditions*

### **Possession of Controlled Substance W College Ave / S 108<sup>th</sup> St**

On Thursday, 11/17/22, at 0306 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was cited for Possession of marijuana pursuant to a traffic stop. He was cited and released on scene and ordered in for booking at a later date.

### **Suspicious Circumstances 2842 W Rawson Ave -Toppers Pizza**

On Thursday, 11/17/22, Franklin squads responded to Toppers Pizza after employees reported a male subject photographing female employees. Contact was made with a subject out of Milwaukee and a consent search of his phone revealed no photographs of employees. He was trespassed from the property and released.

On Thursday, 11/17/22, at 1256 hours, an employee of the Urgent Care center reported a subject had called the facility threatening the receptionist and the healthcare provider who had recently seen his girlfriend. He did not feel she had received adequate treatment. The man was contacted by Officers and advised not to return to the clinic.

### **Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated -1<sup>st</sup> Offense, Battery to Firefighter, Resisting Arrest 7000 Blk S 27<sup>th</sup> Street**

On Thursday, 11/17/22, at 1807 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-1<sup>st</sup> Offense, pursuant to a crash. She later provided an evidentiary blood sample after a search warrant was obtained and executed, the results of which are not yet known. She was also cited for Driving Too Fast for Conditions, Operating Without a License, No Insurance, and Resisting Arrest. While en route to a medical facility for the blood draw, she bit a Greendale Fire Fighter.

The subject was turned over to County Jail and charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.

On Thursday, 11/17/22, Menards reported a Retail Theft which had occurred several weeks prior where a subject left the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$873.00. Follow up to continue.

**Death Investigation**  
**8800 Blk W Lake Pointe Dr**

On Friday, 11/18/22, at 1305 hours, FRPD assisted the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office with the investigation of the death of a 67 year old Franklin resident.

**Fire**  
**7800 Blk S Scepter Dr**

On Friday, 11/18/22, FRPD assisted FFD with the investigation of a reported fire at an apartment building. All residents were evacuated until FFD could verify there was no active fire or structural damage.

**Fraud**  
**7200 Blk S 36th St**

On Friday, 11/18/22, a Franklin resident reported unknown actors filed 2021 tax returns using his personally identifying information. This was done without his consent.

**Armed Robbery**  
**6525 S 27th Street -Dunham's**

On Friday, 11/18/22, at 2059 hours, 4 as-yet unidentified actors attempted to leave the store with approximately \$300.00 of 9mm ammunition. When confronted by staff, one of the subjects displayed a handgun. The subjects fled in a vehicle which Officers located and engaged in a pursuit. The pursuit was terminated on I-43 and Howard Avenue.

On Friday, 11/18/22, at approximately 1746 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Retail Theft after attempting to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$59.99. He was booked, cited, and released. The subject also had a warrant through Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office for Trespassing, however, they would not take custody of him due to the current health emergency.

On Friday, 11/18/22, at 1632 hours, FRPD assisted the Milwaukee County Medical Examiner's Office with the investigation of the death of a 41 year old Franklin resident.

## **11/20/2022**

### **Absolute Sobriety Violation 8200 Blk W Puetz Rd**

On Sunday, 11/20/22, at 0306 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Violation of Absolute Sobriety (Operating with alcohol in system under the age of 21) after she was involved in a traffic crash with another vehicle. She later provided an evidentiary breath sample which indicated that she had a Prohibited Alcohol Concentration of 0.09. She was booked, cited, and turned over to a sober party.

### **Fraud 7900 Blk W Beacon Hill Dr**

On Sunday, 11/20/22, a Franklin resident reported an unauthorized person(s) had used his personally identifying information to open an account with ATT which he was notified was past due. This was done without his consent.

### **Rescue 11900 W Woodcrest Cir**

On Sunday, 11/20/22, Officers responded to a residence to the report of a disturbance and a severely injured subject. Officers determined a subject suffered sever lacerations to his arm while attempting to enter his residence through a window. Another subject on scene attempted to restrain the injured party which led to a struggle. The injured party was transported to a medical facility. No parties wished to be a complainant.
