The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

11/21/2022

Motor Vehicle Theft 10000 Blk S 54th St

On Monday, 11/21/22, a Franklin resident reported that between Friday, 11/18/22, at 1700 hours, and Monday, 11/21/22, at 0730 hours, unknown actor(s) removed a trailer from his property without consent.

Obstructing S 27th St/W Riverwood Blvd

On Monday, 11/21/22, at approximately 2214 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Obstructing after providing a false name to Officers during a traffic stop. He was also cited for Operating After Suspension. He was booked, cited, and released.

11/22/2022

Possession of Controlled Substance/Drug Paraphernalia W Forest Hill Ave/S 28th St

On Tuesday, 11/22/22, at 0339 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Possession of Cocaine pursuant to a traffic stop. She was booked, cited, and released. Charges were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

On Tuesday, 11/22/22, at 0138 hours, a pursuit was initiated pursuant to a traffic stop for Expired Registration when the vehicle fled from officers. The pursuit was terminated in the area of N 39th St and W Lisbon Ave, Milwaukee, when officers lost sight of the vehicle. Follow up to continue with the license plate number obtained.

On Tuesday, 11/22/22, at approximately 1350 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft after attempting to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$378.16. She was booked, cited, and released.

On Tuesday, 11/22/22, at approximately 1809 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with South Milwaukee PD for Retail Theft and Contempt of Court. He was released after signing a Personal Recognizance Bond.

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Obstructing
S 27th St/W Drexel Ave

On Wednesday, 11/23/22, at 0300 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Obstructing, and Operating After Suspension. This occurred pursuant to a traffic stop during which the subject exited the vehicle and continually ignored Officers commands. He was found to be in possession of several crack pipes. He was booked, cited, and released.

Possession of Controlled Substance
W Rawson Ave/W Loomis Rd

On Wednesday, 11/23/22, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana and cited for Operating Without a Valid Driver's License and No Insurance. A passenger in the vehicle was also cited for Possession of Marijuana. Both were booked, cited, and released.

11/25/2022

Disorderly Conduct 10741 S 27th St - On The Border

On Friday, 11/25/22, at approximately 0200 hours, two subjects got into a physical altercation in the parking lot of On The Border. All parties fled prior to Officer arrival but one vehicle was located by Oak Creek Officers at which time it was discovered one of the individuals involved had received a laceration during the altercation which required medical attention. That subject did not wish to be a complainant. Contact was not made with the other actor.

Traffic Crash - Injury 6701 S 27th St - Walmart

On Friday, 11/25/22, a pedestrian was struck by a vehicle in the parking lot of Walmart. The pedestrian was transported to an area hospital with minor injuries. The driver of the vehicle stayed on scene and was identified by officers.

Retail Theft 6525 S 27th St - Dunham's

On Friday, 11/25/22, at 1152 hours, two as-yet unidentified subjects fled the store with a large amount of ammunition without paying for it. Follow up to continue.

Disorderly Conduct – Domestic Violence, Obstructing 8253 S 27th Street - Embassy Motel

On Saturday, 11/26/22, at 2142 hours, at the Embassy Motel, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct- Domestic Violence related and Obstructing. This occurred after he physically restrained his domestic partner from leaving their motel room, causing her to fear for her safety. He then provided false information to responding Officers and attempted to prevent them from accessing the motel room. He was booked, cited, and released after posting bail. Charges were referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office for review.

11/27/2022

Possession of Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute, Carrying Concealed Weapon, Disorderly Conduct 10741 S 27th St - On The Border

On Sunday, 11/27/22, at approximately 0204 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Cocaine W/ Intent to Deliver, Possession of Fentanyl W/Intent to Deliver, Possession of Marijuana, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, and Urinating in Public. This occurred after he was observed by an Officer urinating in the parking lot while carrying a concealed handgun. He was in possession of a large amount of cocaine and fentanyl, US Currency, and an electronic scale. A subject in his company was taken into custody on a probation violation. Both subjects were taken to County Jail. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.

Battery – Domestic Violence 3900 Blk W Heatheridge Dr

On Sunday, 11/27/22, 0212 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Battery – Domestic Violence after she had bitten her domestic partner, causing pain and injury. She was booked and released after posting bail. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.

On Sunday, 11/27/22, a Franklin resident reported a Verizon account was opened using his personally identifying information. This was done without his consent.

On Sunday, 11/27/22, at 1634 hours, 2 subjects out of Milwaukee were taken into custody for Retail Theft after they attempted to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$201.20. Both were booked, cited, and released.
