10/11/21 – 10/17/21

Suspicious Circumstances

10750 W Speedway Dr

Female attempted to leave the Kwik Trip with several cartons of cigarettes she had taken from the cashier. Described as a female white, 5'7", dirty blonde curly hair, baseball hat, and a pink Steve Madden bag. Vehicle was described as a smaller Black SUV. See associated burglary call.

Burglary

7610 W Rawson Ave

Officers responded to 7 Eleven for forced entry burglary. A large paver was used to break the south front glass door. The building was cleared and no suspects were located inside. Unknown number of cartons of cigarettes and unknown number of lottery tickets were taken. 7 Eleven footage shows same female as attempted theft at Kwik Trip.

10/12/21

Theft

3000blk W Statesman Way

Victim reported that sometime between 1330 hours on 10/11/21, and 1100 hours on 10/12/21, unknown actor(s) entered her unlocked Kia Forte while parked in the secured underground garage at 3015 Statesman Way without consent. Items taken from vehicle

On Tuesday, 10/12/21, at approximately 2115 hours, a suspect was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, subject to a rescue call at a residence.

10/13/21

Property Damage

2855 W. Statesman Way,

Victim reported that between Tuesday, 10/12/2021 at 1900 hours and Wednesday, 10/13/2021 at 0500 hours, unknown actors smashed the front passenger side window on her 2018 Kia Sportage. This occurred in the lower secured parking garage at 2855 W Statesman Way. Nothing was reported stolen from the vehicle.

Threat Complaint

Mulligan's, 8973 S. 27th St.

Subject called to report that another subject at the restaurant threatened him with a kitchen knife. Caller stated the subject left with one knife in his waist band and one in each hand. The caller did not remain on scene to speak with Officers and contact was made with the alleged suspect who denied the allegations.

Attempted Theft

10550 W. Cortez Cir

Witness called 911 reporting subjects attempting to cut catalytic converter off of vehicles in the lot of 10554 West Cortez. Witness observed a dark colored sedan, possibly a Dodge Charger or Challenger, fleeing the area at a high rate of speed following the attempted theft.

Mutual Aid / Follow Up

At 0330 hours, Muskego PD requested Mutual Aid to a traffic stop on W. Loomis Ct. at S. 124th St. Muskego PD stopped a vehicle regarding a speed and registration violation at which time a Sawzall was observed in the back seat of the vehicle. A subsequent canine positive indication on the vehicle led to the discovery of a catalytic converter, Sawzall blades, and a black ski mask (clue). This led to an arrest of the passenger for Obstructing and Probation Violation. Items collected for evidence / follow up.

Eluding/Obstructing/Hit and Run

House of Corrections, 8885 S 68th St

Employee from HOC called to report a female in the parking lot picking up an inmate, possibly under the influence. Officers made contact at the vehicle at which time it fled from the HOC parking lot and a pursuit ensued (2.6 miles). The pursuit was terminated by the pursuing Officer in the 3100 block Ryan Rd. After termination, the suspect vehicle was involved in a minor crash with no injuries at W Ryan Road and S 27th Street. OCPD took up the pursuit and the vehicle fled northbound on I94. HOC staff provided officers with the identity of the driver. Suspect will be charged with Eluding, obstructing (gave a different WI DL to officers upon contact), and Recklessly Endangering Safety.

Theft

10566 W Cortez Cir

Victim reports the theft of her catalytic converter from her 2008 Toyota Prius. This occurred between 10/12/21, 1700 hours and 10/13/21, 0800 hours, in the parking lot at 10566 West Cortez Circle.

10/14/21

Trespass to Property

10125 W Loomis Rd Its - All Good Auto Repair

A suspect was taken into custody for Trespass to Property. This occurred after the owner of an RV parked at the property called and stated he believed someone had been in the RV without permission. The RV was unsecured and showed no signs of forced entry and nothing was taken nor damaged. Found in the RV was a backpack containing the suspects ID and two recent citations issued by our department. The suspect admitted to entering the unlocked RV to "look around".

Retail Theft

Suspect was taken into custody for Retail Theft and Possession of Methamphetamine. Merchandise in the amount of \$75.20 was taken. Charges for Possession of Methamphetamine will be referred to the District Attorney's Office upon confirmation of the suspected drugs.

10/15/21

Assist Other Department

Whitnall Park Dr/W College Ave

Officer observed a vehicle traveling southbound on Whitnall Park Dr from W College Ave, driving very slowly with the trunk open. The driver of the vehicle stated she dropped off 2 additional subjects who are possibly hunting in the park. Greendale and Hales Corners PD responded to the area. HCPD requested FRPD drone to respond to assist in checking the area. DNR also responded to the scene. A second subject was located by HCPD. The third subject was later located at his residence in Greenfield. Subjects stated they shot a deer in the park earlier with a crossbow.
