10/18/21

Retail Theft

7780 S Lover's Lane Rd – Pick N Save

On Monday, 10/18/21, at 1111 hours, on the 7600blk of South Barbian Court, a suspect out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Retail Theft and for having three valid warrants; one with Franklin Police Department for Retail Theft, one with Waukesha County Sheriff for Possession of Cocaine, and one with Ozaukee County Sheriff for Retail Theft.

Operating without Owner's Consent

6701 S 27th St - Wal-Mart Supercenter

On Monday, 10/18/21, at approximately 1129 hours, at Wal Mart, a suspect out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle Without Owner's Consent after they were found operating a vehicle reported stolen through Wauwatosa PD. The suspect also possessed valid warrants with Oak Creek Police for Possession of THC and Milwaukee County Sheriff for Paternity/Failure to Support. The vehicle's passenger was taken into custody for having 2 valid warrants with Waukesha County Sheriff for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Bail Jumping.

Charges for OMVWOC will be referred to the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.

10/19/21

Substantial Battery-Domestic Violence 8151 S. 27th St – Plaza Motel

On Tuesday, 10/19/21, at 0049 hours, at the Plaza Motel, 8515 South 27th Street, a subject from Franklin reported a Domestic Violence-Substantial Battery Incident after he was battered by his son. The suspect punched and kicked the victim in the face causing substantial injury. The suspect fled the scene prior to officer arrival, taking the victim's vehicle without his permission. A Temporary Felony Warrant was issued for the suspect.

Burglary 7009 S. 27th St - Deadstock

On Tuesday, 10/19/21, at 0649 hours, officers were dispatched to Deadstock, on the report of a glass break at the front entry door. A passerby observed the damage during a walk and contacted police one hour later. Upon arrival, officers made entry and confirmed a Burglary occurred. Security video showed two suspects, wearing hoodies and gloves, forced entry to the business by throwing a rock through the front glass door.

Retail Theft 6701 S 27 St - Walmart

On Tuesday, 10/19/21, at approximately 1252 hours, at Walmart, a suspect out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Retail Theft. This occurred after the suspect was observed swaping price tags on higher valued items with lesser valued items. Suspect was booked, cited, and released on scene.

Retail Theft 7240 S 76 St – Harry's True Value

Unidentified suspect exited the store carrying a shop-vac valued at approximately \$40 without paying for it. Suspect fled in a white SUV.

10/20/21

Felony Warrant Service 9500blk S. Ryan Green Ct.

On Wednesday, 10/20/21, at 0631 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody on a Felony Department of Corrections warrant for Child Abuse - Recklessly Cause Great Harm. The suspect was turned over to Milwaukee Secure Detention Facility Personnel.

Threats Complaint / Representations Depicting Nudity 6800blk S 50th St.

A Franklin resident reported engaging in an explicit exchange via Zoom. The suspect took a video capture of the exchange without consent (*which is a felony under SS 942.09*) and threatened to send the video to the victim's friends, demanding \$500 from the victim. The victim was advised not to send money or have any further contact with the suspect.

Assist FFD S. 27th St./W. Oakwood Rd.

On Wednesday, 10/20/21, at 0257 hours, FRPD officers assisted FFD establish a landing zone at Ascension Franklin Hospital, 10101 South 27th Street, for a Flight for Life landing. Traffic was shut down on West Oakwood Road at South 27th Street and South 34th Street, respectively. Traffic remained shut down until released by FFD.

Warrant Arrest Franklin PD

Suspect from previous days Domestic Violence incident turned himself in at the Franklin Police Department. Subject was transported to County Jail. Charges of Substantial Battery and Domestic Violence are being referred to the District Attorney's Office.

Stolen Vehicle/Eluding S 27th / W Sycamore

Officers located a vehicle reported stolen by Milwaukee PD, a tan 2004 Toyota Sienna minivan, in the parking lot of Home Depot. A traffic stop was attempted near W Northwest Mutual Way road at which time the vehicle led Officers on a pursuit. The vehicle crashed at the W College Avenue park and ride in Oak Creek, where the driver fled on foot and was not located.

Theft

10594 W Cortez Cir

Victim reported that sometime between Saturday, 10/09/21 and 10/20/21, at 10594 W Cortez Cir, unknown actor(s) stole a package from the package room at the apartment complex. Item stolen was shoes, valued at \$80.00.

Battery – Domestic Violence 3400blk W Sycamore St

6300BLK S 35th St**

On Friday, 10/22/21, at 0220 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana and Carrying Concealed Weapon. The subject was on bail at the time of the incident and charges will be referred to the District Attorney for Bail Jumping. A second subject was taken into custody on a Franklin warrant.

Pursuit / Eluding

The suspect refused to provide an evidentiary blood sample. A warrant for the suspect's blood was obtained and a forced blood draw was later conducted. Charges for OWI 2nd are pending for blood results.
