10/25/21

Felony Warrant / Possess Controlled Substance-THC /Operate After Revocation 4500 Blk W Ryan Rd.

On Monday, 10/25/21, at 0306 hours, on the 4500 Blk of W Ryan Rd, a suspect was taken into custody for having a valid Felony warrant with Milwaukee County Sheriff for Fleeing and 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, Possession of THC, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Operating after Revocation. Subject was turned over to MCSO.

Carrying a Concealed Weapon 6600 Blk W Drexel Ave

On Monday, 10/25/21, at 1210 hours, on the 6600 Blk of West Drexel Avenue, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Carrying a Concealed Weapon (Firearm), Possession of THC, and having a valid Warrant with the Milwaukee Police Department for Larceny. Upon a search of the vehicle he was driving, a loaded handgun was found in the glove box. Possess THC & Tobacco on School Grounds 8222 S 51 St – Franklin High School

On Tuesday, 10/26/21, an FHS student was cited for Possession of THC and Possession of Tobacco Product On School Grounds after the student was found to be in possession of two disposable vaping devices, one of which contained THC oil.

Battery 8222 S 51 St – Franklin High School

On Tuesday, 10/26/21, an FHS student was cited for Battery. This had occurred after the student struck another student once in the face, causing a laceration.

Victim reported that sometime between Friday, 10/22/21, and Tuesday, 10/26/21, at 0830 hours, an unknown actor(s) removed one of two catalytic converters from a 2015 white Ford F250. This was done while it was parked overnight in the parking lot of Innovative Health.

Fire
5801 W Franklin Dr – Allis Roller

Franklin PD and Franklin Fire Department responded to Allis Roller and put out a fire involving a roof ventilation unit. No injuries reported. Franklin Fire Department advised nothing suspicious.

Victim reported sometime in the last week, unknown actor(s) removed a mountain bike valued at approximately \$1,000 from the garage of her residence.

Eluding
9200 W Loomis Rd

On Thursday, 10/28/21, at 2230 hours, Franklin Police were involved in a pursuit with a gold Pontiac after a traffic stop for speed was attempted. Officers terminated the pursuit after losing sight of the vehicle in a neighborhood near West Brunn Drive/Elroy Court. Shortly after, a caller reported the vehicle in the back yard of their residence on Imperial Dr and that a male and female had fled the scene. The female was located shortly afterwards and was taken into custody for Obstructing, Prowling, Possession of THC, Destruction of Property and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

10/28/21

Obstructing / Felony Warrant Service
6600 Blk W Drexel Ave.

On Thursday, 10/28/21, at 0445 hours, on the 6600 block of West Drexel Ave, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Obstructing and a valid Felony warrant with WI Community Corrections for Probation Violation for Fleeing / Eluding. This occurred pursuant to a field interview at the above location.

Fleeing-Eluding/Operate Motor Vehicle Without Consent/Resisting/Warrant Service
5040 W Rawson Ave – Kwik Trip

On Thursday, 10/28/21, at 0503 hours, at Kwik Trip, 5040 West Rawson Avenue, a suspect out of Park Falls was taken into custody for Fleeing/Eluding, Operating Without Owners Consent, Criminal Damage to Property, Resisting/Obstructing an Officer. The suspect had

been identified as the driver of the vehicle from the Eluding that took place a few hours prior on W Loomis Rd. The vehicle had been determined to be stolen. The subject also had a body only Warrant with Waukesha Sheriff's Office for Criminal Damage to Property, Disorderly Conduct, and Possession of THC.

Armed Robbery/Motor Vehicle Theft

Officers responded to Glendale PD and made contact with the alleged victim of an Armed Robbery and Kidnapping that occurred in the City of Franklin. The victim reported that on 10/27/21, at approximately 2300 hours, an unknown subject forced him to relinquish his vehicle keys at gun point. The suspect forced the victim into the vehicle and both parties proceeded to drive around the north side of Milwaukee for approximately two hours until the victim was released in the City of Glendale and the actor continued on with his vehicle.

10/29/21

Disorderly Conduct 8100 Blk S 59th St

On Friday, 10/29/21 at approximately 1255 a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct. This occurred after the suspect confronted the victim at their residence and attempted to pepper spray them. The dispute stemmed from an issue involving both women and their relationship with a third party.

Victim reported being duped in a gift card scam. This occurred after the victim received a fraudulent email from " A M A Z O N " that said there was a problem with her account. She then contacted a "representative" over the phone. The representative told her to purchase gift cards and give him the numbers on the back. The victim gave him the numbers to 4 cards, totaling \$800.
