The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

This led to the couple being instructed to withdraw \$14,000 from their bank account which they converted to digital currency at an area gas station. They then sent this digital currency to an unknown recipient.

The school was searched and FRPD confirmed no students or staff were left in the building. Canines were also used to search and clear the school for weapons. Follow up to continue.

On Monday, 10/24/22, an employee of Copart contacted FRPD to report finding drugs in a vehicle which was to be auctioned by the business. Officers responded and took possession approximately 20 ounces of marijuana. This vehicle was a recovered stolen auto from Milwaukee PD on 10/12/22.

During this incident, a bystander was repeatedly told to leave the area due to the possible public safety risk involved in the Officers attempts to take the armed subject into custody. This subject's actions created a safety risk to Officers and interfered with the investigation. This subject was later taken into custody for Obstructing. He was released after posting bail and charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.
