Some incidents may have been omitted to preserve the integrity of an ongoing investigation or to protect a victim. Addresses are not specified in some cases, referred to instead by block.

The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

10/03/2022

Possession of Controlled Substance, Resisting Arrest, Carry Concealed Weapon 8253 S 27th St – Embassy Motel

On Monday, 10/03/22, at 0047 hours, at the Embassy Motel, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Operating After Revocation- Misdemeanor, Resisting Arrest, Possession With Intent to Deliver Schedule Narcotics, Possession With Intent to Deliver-Cocaine, Carry Concealed Weapon, and Possession of Marijuana. This occurred pursuant to a traffic stop. The subject was later transported to County Jail with charges referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.

On Monday, 10/03/22, a victim reported his vehicle was taken from his driveway with keys during the overnight hours. A bicycle was left in its place. Security video showed the vehicle was taken by juveniles who had been traveling by bicycle.

Disorderly Conduct
9900 Blk S 57th St

On Tuesday, 10/4/22, at 0705 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct and Trespass to Land. This occurred after he was involved in a road rage incident on W Ryan Road and confronted the other party involved in the parking lot of their employer. The subject threatened the other party and caused a disturbance. This was the second incident at this location involving this subject and the offender had previously been trespassed from the property.

On Thursday, 10/06/22, a resident of Franklin reported that earlier in the year, he had given his debit card information to an unknow subject after receiving a scam email. The victim had since discovered several thousand dollars in unauthorized charges.

Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing, Warrant Arrest 6941 S Riverwood Blvd -Goodwill Industries

On Thursday, 10/06/22, at approximately 1508 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Obstructing and for having a warrant with the Milwaukee County Sheriff for Trespassing. This occurred after the subject created a disturbance inside the store and refused to identify himself to Officers. He was booked, cited, and released as MCSO would not take custody of the subject due to the ongoing health emergency.

On Thursday, 10/06/22, at 2326 hours, a subject out of Racine was taken into custody for Possession of Marijuana and having a valid warrant with River Hills Police Department for Resist/Obstruct Officer. This occurred pursuant to a traffic stop. He was booked, cited, and released after signing a Personal Recognizance Bond.

On Saturday, 10/08/22, at 0213 hours, a subject out of Hales Corners was taken into custody for Operating a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated-3rd Offense. The subject refused to provide an evidentiary chemical test of his blood. He was booked, cited, and released to a sober party after posting bail. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office.

On Saturday, 10/08/22, at approximately 2301 hours, a subject was taken into custody for Retail Theft, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, and Trespassing. This occurred after he attempted to leave the store with unpaid merchandise valued at \$104.12. He was booked, cited, and released.

10/09/2022

Possession of Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Resisting Arrest S 27th Street/W Forest Hill Ave

On Sunday, 10/09/22, at 0220 hours, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Cocaine and Resisting Arrest. This occurred pursuant to a traffic stop. He was booked, cited, and released after posting bail. Charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office. A passenger in the vehicle was cited for Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Possession of Controlled Substance, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia 8361 S 27th Street -Skyway Motel

On Sunday, 10/09/22, at 0116 hours, at Skyway, 8361 South 27th Street, a subject out of Milwaukee was taken into custody for Possession of Controlled Substance and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The offenses were discovered pursuant to an Officer initiated field interview. The subject was booked, cited, and released on scene.

Burglary, Resisting Arrest, Felon in Possession of Firearm, Possession of Stolen Property, Warrant Arrest
9335 S 27th St -American Motel

On Sunday, 10/9/22, at 0755 hours, officers responded to the call of a Burglary at the American Motel. A suspect was identified on review of security cameras and a description was broadcasted via radio. After the message was announced, Oak Creek Police observed the subject in the 2000 block of W Ryan Rd and a foot pursuit ensued. Subsequent calls came in from several citizens and the suspect was taken into custody after a Taser deployment in the 2900 block of W Central Ave. The subject was found to be in possession of a stolen firearm at the time of his capture.

At approximately 1021 hours, after being medically cleared at an area hospital, while handcuffed, the subject ran from the transport officer and fled east from the hospital. During the foot pursuit, the subject was able to break the shackle on the cuffs and at approximately 1130 hours, was taken into custody in the 1800 block of Oakwood Rd with the assistance of OCPD. The subject required medical attention and during the second medical clearance, while leg shackled he again attempted to run from officers and was detained quickly. During the detainment, a hospital door was damaged. He was taken to County Jail with numerous charges referred to the District Attorney's Office.

Warrant Arrest
9455 W Loomis Rd -Franklin Police Department

On Sunday, 10/09/22, at approximately 1650 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having a valid warrant with the Franklin Police Department for Loitering. He was released after signing a Personal Recognizance Bond.
