The Milwaukee County Criminal Justice Facility is currently only accepting Felony and Domestic Violence offenders due to the ongoing health emergency. The House of Corrections currently will not accept prisoners held on municipal warrants.

**Rescue**  
**8361 S 27th St – Skyway Motel**

On Monday, 10/31/22, Officers responded to the Skyway Motel to the report of an overdose. Officers administered Narcan and revived the subject who was later transported by Franklin Fire Department to an area hospital.

**Battery- Domestic Violence**  
**6350 S 108th St -Kinder Care**

On Monday, 10/31/22, at Kinder Care, a subject out of Milwaukee struck the mother of his child several times in the face causing injury. He fled prior to Officer arrival but was later located and taken into custody. He was transported to County Jail with charges of Battery-Domestic Violence referred to the District Attorney's Office for review.

**Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing, Warrant Arrest**  
**6500 Blk S 35th Street**

On Monday, 10/31/22, at approximately 1626 hours at South 26th Street and West Mangold Avenue, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct, Obstructing, and having a Department of Corrections warrant for Probation Violation. This occurred after he fled from Officers attempting to take him into custody on the warrant and made threats to

**Retail Theft

### **Warrant Arrest 11000 Blk W St Martins Rd**

On Friday, 11/04/22, at 1055 hours, a subject was taken into custody for having two Warrants with the West Allis Police Department for traffic offenses. The subject was released on scene after signing a Personal Recognizance bond.

### **Carry Concealed Weapon, Obstructing, Possession Controlled Substance/Paraphernalia S Carmel Dr/W Rawson Ave**

On Friday, 11/04/22, at approximately 1806 hours, a resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Carrying a Concealed Weapon, Obstructing, Possession of Marijuana, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
