Disorderly Conduct – 2308 hours 8253 S 27th St – The Embassy Motel

A resident of Franklin was taken into custody for Disorderly Conduct after dispatch received multiple calls from patrons of the motel reporting she was creating a disturbance. She was booked, cited, and released.

Theft - 0943 hours 9575 S 27th St - Staybridge Suites

A subject staying at the hotel reported an unknown actor(s) had stolen money from her purse.
